track and football field at Burns Junior/Senior High School and funding for a new Pine Bluffs Elementary School. He also stated that a number of large facilities projects have been completed, including renovation of the Pine Bluffs High School gymnasium and additions to buildings.

Over the past six years, technology has been introduced into the high school, a one-to-one computer initiative, which Bryant

is proud of, and the transportation fleet has increased in size as enrollment has increased.

Bryant said he and his staff worked hard to get the processes and procedures used by the district cleaned up, and that audits have been excellent. He also said a number of people under his supervision have been hired, and he could not be more proud of them. "I just get out of their way and let them do what they were hired to do," he said.

And, while he is excited to

be going back to work for the Department of Education, stating that leadership there has undergone a tremendous change for the good, and he will be working with a dynamic group of individuals, he will be sad to leave the school district.

The state superintendent said she is happy to have Bryant joining her administration, and looks forward to moving education ahead in Wyoming.
